

Getting To Big Bear and the Three Pines Lodge

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The Three Pines Lodge is conveniently located on Big Bear Blvd. (aka Highway 18) just two miles East of the dam in Boulder Bay. When traveling to the Big Bear area there are *three routes* to choose from. State Hwy 330 /

Hwy 18 through Running Springs is the fastest and easiest route, however, it can get congested on weekends and busy holidays. Highway 38 through Redlands is a bit longer, but is the most scenic and often has less traffic than Hwy 330 / Hwy 18. Finally there is Highway 18 through the Lucerne Valley, which gets less snowfall during storms and has the least amount of mountain driving. It is a good idea to choose your route depending on weather conditions and day of the week, and remember to always carry chains in your vehicle when traveling in the mountains.



Route 1: **HWY 330 / HWY 18 THROUGH RUNNING SPRINGS**

From The Los Angeles Area:

Take Interstate 10 East, to the 30 freeway North, to Hwy. 330 East. Hwy. 330 goes through Running Springs and turns into Hwy. 18. Follow Hwy. 18 East and turn right across the Big Bear Lake dam. Three Pines is one of the first Lodges as you come into town, just 2 miles past the dam on your left.

From Orange County Or The South Bay Area:

Take the 91 East (or the 55 North to the 91 East), to the 215 North, to Interstate 10 East, to the 30 freeway North, to Hwy. 330 East. Hwy. 330 goes through Running Springs and turns into Hwy. 18. Follow Hwy. 18 East and turn right across the Big Bear Lake dam. Three Pines is one of the first Lodges as you come into town, just 2 miles past the dam on your left.

From The San Diego Area:

Take Interstate 15 North, to the 215 North, to Interstate 10 East, to the 30 freeway North, to Hwy. 330 East, which will take you up into the mountains. Hwy. 330 goes through Running Springs and turns into Hwy. 18. Follow Hwy. 18 East and turn right across the Big Bear Lake dam. Three Pines is one of the first Lodges as you come into town, just 2 miles past the dam on your left.

From The San Fernando Valley Area:

Take the 101 East, to the 134 East, to the 210 East, to Interstate 10 East, to the 30 freeway North, to Hwy. 330 East, which will take you up into the mountains. Hwy. 330 goes through Running Springs and turns into Hwy. 18. Follow Hwy. 18 East and turn right across the Big Bear Lake dam. Three Pines is one of the first Lodges as you come into town, just 2 miles past the dam on your left.

Route 2: **HWY 38 THROUGH REDLANDS**

From The Los Angeles Area:

Take Interstate 10 East, past Hwy 30, to the Orange Street exit (Hwy 38). There will be a stop sign at the bottom of the off ramp, continue straight 1 block to Orange Street, turn left. After approximately 1 mile turn right on East Lugonia Ave (Hwy 38). Follow Hwy 38 through Mentone to Big Bear City. Hwy 38 will turn left onto Big Bear Blvd. At the first stoplight (Greenway Drive), Hwy 38 turns right. Stay straight on Big Bear Blvd, which is now Hwy 18. Follow Big Bear Blvd through Big Bear City into Big Bear Lake past the shopping centers and Village. Three Pines Lodge is just 2 miles past the Village on your right.

From Orange County or South Bay Area:

Take the 91 East (or the 55 North to the 91 East), to the 215 North, to Interstate 10 East, past Hwy 30, to the Orange Street exit (Hwy 38). There will be a stop sign at the bottom of the off ramp, continue straight 1 block to Orange Street, turn left. After approximately 1 mile turn right on East Lugonia Ave (Hwy 38). Follow Hwy 38 through Mentone to Big Bear City. Hwy 38 will turn left onto Big Bear Blvd. At the first stoplight (Greenway Drive), Hwy 38 turns right. Stay straight on Big Bear Blvd, which is now Hwy 18. Follow Big Bear Blvd through Big Bear City into Big Bear Lake past the shopping centers and Village. Three Pines Lodge is just 2 miles past the Village on your right.

From The San Diego Area:

Take Interstate 15 North, to the 215 North, to Interstate 10 East, past Hwy 30, to the Orange Street exit (Hwy 38). There will be a stop sign at the bottom of the off ramp, continue straight 1 block to Orange Street, turn left. After approximately 1 mile turn right on East Lugonia Ave (Hwy 38). Follow Hwy 38 through Mentone to Big Bear City. Hwy 38 will turn left onto Big Bear Blvd. At the first stoplight (Greenway Drive), Hwy 38 turns right. Stay straight on Big Bear Blvd, which is now Hwy 18. Follow Big Bear Blvd through Big Bear City into Big Bear Lake past the shopping centers and Village. Three Pines Lodge is just 2 miles past the Village on your right.

From The Palm Springs Area:

Take Interstate 10 West to Yucaipa. Take the County Line Road off-ramp. Turn right. Follow County Line Road to Bryant St. Turn left. Follow Bryant St. to Highway 38. Turn right onto Highway 38, which will turn left onto Big Bear Blvd in Big Bear City. At the first stoplight (Greenway Drive), Hwy 38 turns right. Stay straight on Big Bear Blvd, which is now Hwy 18. Follow Big Bear Blvd through Big Bear City into Big Bear Lake past the shopping centers and Village. Three Pines Lodge is just 2 miles past the Village on your right.

Route 3: HWY 18 THROUGH THE LUCERNE VALLEY

From The Los Angeles and San Fernando Valley Areas:

Take the 210 Freeway North or Interstate 10 East to Interstate 15 North. Follow the 15 North over the Cajon Pass towards Victorville and take the Bear Valley Road exit. Turn right (East) at Hwy 18 through the Lucerne Valley. Hwy 18 will take you into the Big Bear Valley. Follow this road along the North Shore of Big Bear Lake to the Standfield Cut off, turn left and proceed over the bridge. At the stop light turn right and follow Big Bear Blvd past the shopping centers and Village. Three Pines Lodge is just 2 miles past the Village on your right.

From The San Diego Area:

Take the 15 North to the 215 North, which merges into the 15 North. Follow the 15 North over the Cajon Pass towards Victorville and take the Bear Valley Road exit. Turn right (East) at Hwy 18 towards Lucerne Valley. In Lucerne Valley Hwy 18 bears to the right taking you into the Big Bear Valley. Follow this road along the North Shore of Big Bear Lake to the Standfield Cut off, turn left and proceed over the bridge. At the stop light turn right and follow Big Bear Blvd past the shopping centers and Village. Three Pines Lodge is just 2 miles past the Village on your right.

From the Orange County or the South Bay Area:

Take the 91 East (or the 55 North to the 91 East) to the 215 North. The 215 North merges into the 15 North. Follow the 15 North over the Cajon Pass towards Victorville and take the Bear Valley Road exit. Turn right (East) at Hwy 18 towards Lucerne Valley. In Lucerne Valley Hwy 18 bears to the right taking you into the Big Bear Valley. Follow this road along the North Shore of Big Bear Lake to the Standfield Cut off, turn left and proceed over the bridge. At the stop light turn right and follow Big Bear Blvd past the shopping centers and Village. Three Pines Lodge is just 2 miles past the Village on your right.

From The Las Vegas Area:

Take the Interstate 15 South, to Hwy 247 South. This will bring you to the Lucerne Valley. Go past two stop signs and turn left onto Hwy 18, which leads up the mountain to the Big Bear Valley. Follow Hwy 18 approximately 6 miles to Stanfield Cutoff. Turn left and proceed over the bridge. At the stop light turn right and follow Big Bear Blvd past the shopping centers and Village. Three Pines Lodge is just 2 miles past the Village on your right.
